## Missions at Work

Missions are at work! The Mission Committee met in September and reviewed the goals which keep us focused on the work that we hope to accomplish. They are Missionary Support, Mission Outreach, Good Earth Village, Disaster Relief, Sunday School and the collection of Econo Foods Receipts.

Through your continued support, we have sent \$1,000 to Karen Anderson, our **missionary** serving in Chile. The **Mission Outreach** group traveled to Cincinnati this past summer; they will share their experiences on October 2<sup>nd</sup>. We continue to support **Good Earth Village** through your coffee fellowship donations. We responded to **Lutheran Disaster Relief** by sending money to help the flood victims in Texas and Louisiana. Our **Sunday School** children and the whole congregation will be working on Christmas Shoeboxes for Hope Coalition in Red Wing; more information to follow! And please keep collecting your **Econo Foods Receipts**. We have already reached our first goal of \$150,000 in receipts! We were able to send \$1,000 to Feed My Starving Children; now we are on our second collection and will receive another \$1,000 as soon as we meet the \$150,000 goal.

We will be holding a **food collection in October, so please watch for more details**. Hastings Family Service prepares Thanksgiving food baskets for families in need. We would like your support in helping with their food collection.
