## Church Cleanup Day

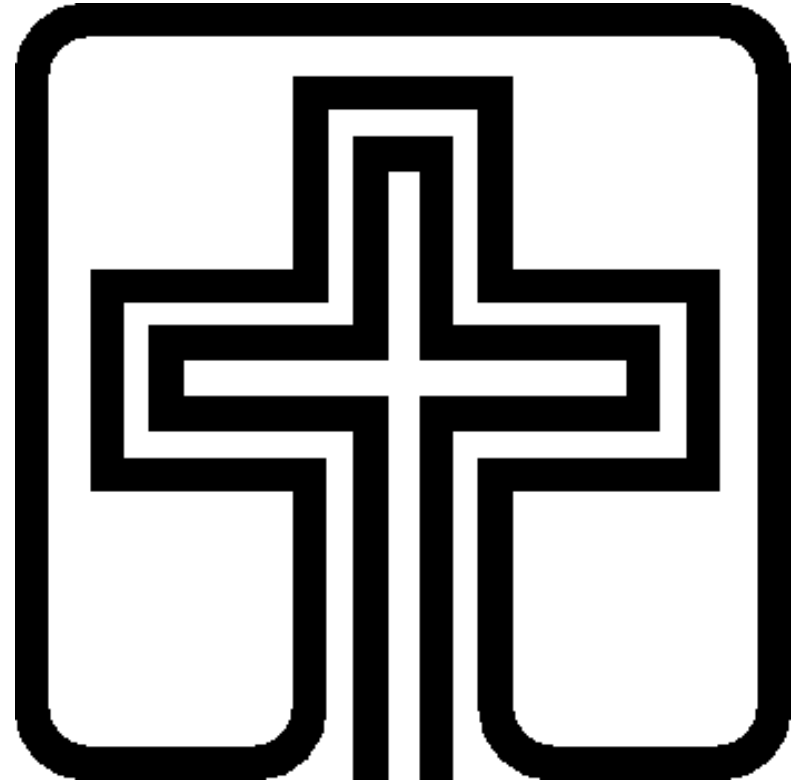
Church cleanup day at Cross of Christ is scheduled for Saturday, October 6, 2012 from 8:00 a.m. until noon. Many hands make fast work.
